Summary of the content of the academic discipline:

The discipline “Practical course of the Russian language” is aimed at improving the overall level of language competence, which largely determines the effectiveness of the professional training of a language teacher. The main goal of this course is to systematize the knowledge of the basics of Russian orthography and punctuation, partially acquired by students while studying the Russian language course during their secondary (or secondary specialized) education; to stimulate further independent work of students in mastering the norms of modern Russian literary language and thus provide practical preparation for students to perceive the discipline “Modern Russian literary language”. Students should know the theoretical foundations of modern orthographic and punctuation norms, be able to apply acquired knowledge in practice, acquire skills in working with dictionaries and specialized reference literature.
