Summary of the content of the academic discipline:

Within the discipline, the basic principles of technology are studied: in printing production, production of photo and film materials, in the creation of audio and audiovisual products, in the processes of television and radio broadcasting, the production of computer and Internet materials. As a result of mastering the discipline, students gain knowledge about the basic principles of technology and the main technological processes of media production, technical means to support their effective management, about key processes in the main segments of media production and the necessary means for their implementation.
