<p>Summary of the content of the academic discipline:</p> <p>The discipline “Information verification in Journalism” is aimed at studying the principles, methods and tools of information verification in digital journalism and consolidating theoretical knowledge in practice. The discipline introduces students to the theoretical foundations of the information verification process in journalism through the study of definitions of basic concepts, revealing the relationship of the information verification process with the categories of “objectivity” and “fact”; forms skills for working with methods and tools for verifying information in journalism, as well as ways to counteract “fake” news and the phenomenon of “post-truth”.</p>
