It provides for the study of the nature of the interaction of law with other social phenomena and processes; the identification of social functions of law; the definition of the social mechanism of law and its elements; the study of factors and conditions that have a positive or negative impact on the implementation of legal provisions in practice, and, accordingly, the determination of the social effectiveness of law; development of methodology and methodology of specific empirical studies of legal phenomena, etc. Mastering the discipline allows you to learn how to predict the consequences of the adoption of regulatory legal acts and the analysis of law enforcement practice, analyze law-making and law enforcement practices, highlighting those acts that do not meet the objective needs of the development of society.</p>
