Competencies to be formed	Mastering of the academic discipline “Judiciary” should ensure basic professional competencies formation: to have a humanistic worldview, to have citizenship and patriotic qualities; to use knowledge about the law system enforcement and judicial bodies of the Republic of Belarus to solve problems related to determining the status, organization and court activities and bodies that promote justice, in order to protect the rights and legitimate interests of citizens, the constitutional order of the state; to take into account the moral requirements for lawyers in carrying out professional activities, to comply with these requirements, to consider the processes of mutual morality and law influence.

Brief content of the academic discipline:

“Judiciary” is an academic discipline, the subject of which is a knowledge system about law enforcement, the judiciary, justice, the court organization and law enforcement agencies in the Republic of Belarus and some foreign countries.

The academic discipline “Judiciary” is one of the disciplines of the state module component “Fundamentals of the state system”. This course introduces future lawyers to the concepts of law enforcement, judicial power, justice, the judiciary, judicial units and instances, prosecutorial supervision, tasks, organization, powers, as well as the main stages in the development of the court and law enforcement agencies (the prosecutor's office, preliminary investigation bodies, bodies justice, advocacy and notaries).
